



Ocotillo Ridge Wellness and Safety Procedures

We are excited to reopen school with procedures in place to keep staff and students safe on campus. Ocotillo Ridge will use the ACT Statement to teach our procedures.



Classroom

- Daily attendance and participation is vital.
- Desks will be arranged to create separation.
- Students at tables will have dividers.
- Social distancing between students in class will be conducted when feasible.
- Students will use personal supplies.
- Handwashing routines will be taught and encouraged throughout the day.
- Classrooms will be sanitized daily and high touch areas frequently.
- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle.

Student Movement

- During transitions, students will walk in single-file lines and will always walk on the right side of the breezeway.
- Small groups will rotate for Reteach/Enrich.
- Students will go to specials. Shared materials will be sanitized between usage.

School Campus

- Daily home health screenings are recommended for students, staff, and campus visitors. Please do not come to school if you are ill, are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have been exposed.
- Face coverings will be worn by students, staff and visitors.
- Students will be taught "good health" practices which include hand washing, physical distancing when feasible, and sneezing and coughing in to elbows.
- Increased good health signage will be posted and sanitation stations will be in classrooms and common areas.
- Volunteers will be allowed on a limited basis. Volunteers must be pre-approved by the volunteer coordinator. At-home volunteer opportunities will also be available.

Recess

- Snack recess and lunch recess will continue with no more than one grade level on the playground at a time. The play structure may be closed.
- Adults will be supervising small groups to support physical distancing.

Breakfast and Lunch

- Lunch tables will be set-up to maintain distance from each other.
- Only 2 classes at each grade level will be in the MPR. Remaining classes will eat in other designated areas.
- Tables will be sanitized in between meals.

Arrival

- For week 1, students will report to their classroom similar to rainy day schedule.
- Following week 1, one grade level at a time will play outside before school with a rotating schedule. All other classes will report to the classroom.

Dismissal

- Kinder students will be picked up in the classroom.
- Grade levels will be dismissed together and specific areas will be designated for grade level parent pick up.
- Physical distancing signs will be posted.
